Dear Neighbors,

In response to the safety concerns shared by many of our residents, the CVC Metro District has installed speed cameras throughout the subdivision. **Because we do not have sidewalks**, it's especially important that everyone drives carefully and respects the posted **25 mph speed limit** so that pedestrians, children, golfers, and pets can safely share our roads.

We're offering a **grace period until June 15, 2026**, for all residents and CVC golf members to adjust to the new system.

New Transponders

If you haven't yet received your new transponder, please stop by the Cordillera Metro District office at **408 Carterville Rd, Edwards** (right next to the Cordillera Post Office). There is **no charge** for the new transponders. Please note that the old-style transponders (license plate mounted and windshield boxes) will be deactivated after June 15, 2026.

Gate Access

- The **West Gate** is transponder-only.
- Visitors should enter through the **East Gate** and register with security.

We kindly ask that residents remind their guests to respect the speed limit—speeding violations will be tied to the resident's account, and repeated issues may result in guest access being limited.

Speeding Violation Process

We want everyone to succeed with this, so here's how it will work:

- **First violation:** A friendly courtesy notice will be sent by email and letter.
- **Second violation:** Transponder deactivated for 30 days (access limited to the East Gate visitor lane).
- **Third violation:** All transponders registered to the address will be deactivated for 60 days (East Gate visitor lane access only).

Good News on Speed Bumps

If we see strong compliance from the community right away, the Board will consider

removing the speed bumps **as early as possible** — well before the end of summer if safety improves significantly.

Thank you in advance for helping us keep Cordillera Valley Club safe and enjoyable for everyone. Let's all have a wonderful and safe summer season!
